The C-43 Water Quality Sampling Team

This team monitored and assessed blue green algae conditions in the C-43 canal over the past several months. For many weeks, sampling events involved a 12-14 hour day in the field -- hauling boats between West Palm Beach and the C-43 canal to collect samples at seven sites as well as conduct surveys along 27 miles of river.

Back at the District's laboratory, collected samples were analyzed, validated and quality assured -- often in less than 24 hours. Data was processed in GIS to produce graphs for analyses and presentation to water managers.

Work efforts undertaken by this team of District science and water quality staff is an example of how highly responsive science is performed in order to support timely management decisions.
