Kevin serves as the District's lead technical expert regarding the United States Environmental Protection Agency's proposed numeric nutrient criteria for Florida. Kevin has worked tirelessly developing and communicating crucial scientific and economic information on the proposed refinement of Florida's surface water classification system that has potentially significant consequences to the District.

He oversees 4 teams that are assessing the economic impacts to the District if such numeric nutrient criteria were imposed. Kevin has worked with the Office of Counsel and Executive Management to formulate District strategies and has coordinated several teams that are focused on different water body types such as streams, lakes, canals and estuaries.

He has served on the Florida Department of Environmental Protection Numeric Nutrient Technical Advisory Committee (since 2003) and represented the District's position at FDEP and USEPA public workshops on this matter.

During the past month, Kevin has represented the District in Tallahassee, Orlando and West Palm Beach public workshops. He has also regularly briefed executive management and Governing Board members, made presentations to the Water Resources Advisory Commission and Governing Board and participated in Congressional Staff briefings in Washington, D.C.
