On January 9, 2009, Lloyd Brown, Crew Chief at the Clewiston Field Station, was traveling south on SR-835 on his way to STA 5 when he was flagged down by a member of the public. When Lloyd pulled his vehicle over to the side of the road, he noticed an overturned vehicle in the canal submerged in about three to four feet of water. When the gentleman who flagged him down indicated that there was a woman in the vehicle, Lloyd immediately offered his assistance to free her.

Lloyd found a piece of scrap metal in the bed of his pickup truck which the man used to shatter the rear window of the submerged vehicle on the passenger side. This enabled the woman to climb out and get to a safe and dry location on the ditch bank. Lloyd remained on the scene until the Hendry County Sherriff's Office and Fire Rescue arrived.
