**SUBJECT:** **4600001252 - STA-1W FPL Midway Levee and Inflow & Distribution Levee Repairs**

### **Background:**

The purpose of this construction contract is to repair the STA-1W FPL Midway Levee and the Inflow & Distribution Levee. The levees have deteriorated due to constant use for vehicular access to the storm water treatment area structures in STA-1W and STA-1E. The work includes restoring the levee roads back to design elevation by constructing a stabilized sub-base and installing base rock.

### **How this helps meet the District's 10-Year Strategic Plan:**

This project is an integral component in the District's 10-year Strategic Plan to refurbish and restore the regional water management system.

### **Funding Source:**

The lowest responsive and responsible bidder is Stanford & Sons Trucking Corporation, with a total bid amount of \$691,828.00, and is budgeted using dedicated funds (Everglades Trust Fund).

### **This Board item impacts what areas of the District, both resource areas and geography:**

This item impacts the Operations and Maintenance Resource Area in Palm Beach County.

### **What concerns could this Board item raise?**

This Request for Bid (RFB) followed standard procurement procedures and the lowest responsive and responsible bidder was selected.

### **Why should the Governing Board approve this item?**

Repair of these critical levee roads is necessary to ensure access to the District's storm water treatment area.
