The South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) is pleased to present a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) from entities interested in submitting a statement of qualifications for the construction of large reservoir embankments and structures in South Florida.

The value of the project(s) is expected to be over \$200 million, with a project site over 10,000 acres. Prime contractors will be expected to have comparable reservoir construction experience. Anticipated services may include, but not be limited to: site clearing and grubbing and removal of muck (organic soil), drilling, blasting and excavation of in situ materials for use in the embankments, construction of engineered embankments, roads, bridges, excavation and shaping of seepage/borrow canals; construction of slurry cutoff walls, seepage blankets and chimney drains; application of soil-cement admixture for embankment protection; and installation of pump stations and water control structures. Minimum qualifications/requirements will be stated in the RFQ.

A list of potential sub-contractors who are already registered with SFWMD will be distributed at a pre-solicitation meeting.

The South Florida Water Management District is a regional, governmental agency that oversees the water resources in the southern half of the state. A key initiative is clean up and restoration of the Everglades
