Project Operations and Project Implementation Report (PIR)

- **PIR contains and describes the project operations**
- **Provides Environmental Assessment and NEPA coverage for the range of project operations that will be implemented**
- **Describes the Monitoring Plan to measure environmental benefits and assurances**




Project Operation Manual (POM) Development Process

- Each PIR will include a Draft POM as an annex to the PIR
- The Draft POM will be updated and revised as necessary for subsequent phases of project implementation
- Prior to the completion of project construction, the assumptions in the Draft POM will be reviewed and updated
- The Draft POM will be revised as appropriate and promulgated as the Preliminary POM for use during the Operational Testing and Monitoring Phase
- A Final POM will be completed for the long-term operations and maintenance phase of the project

Future Considerations for PIR Operations Plan

- **Additional input on the Draft POM will be requested and considered as part of the formal comment period following the agency release Draft PIR in February, 2009**
- **The next phase, the Preliminary POM, will be developed for use during the operational testing and monitoring phase**



Future Considerations for Expedited Project Operations Plan

- **The Preliminary POM will include additional project details such as:**
 - **Detailed design information for project features**
 - **Detailed flow diagrams for project features**
 - **Additional details on the testing and monitoring of operational changes**
 - **Potential operations will be consistent with the Tentatively Selected Plan**



Future Considerations for Expedited Project Operations Plan (cont.)

- Detailed Design is underway and the Preliminary Engineering design will be presented to the WRAC
- Preliminary POM will be developed in parallel to the detailed design phase
- Draft Preliminary POM will be presented to WRAC and Governing Board
- The Draft Preliminary POM is expected to be completed by October, 2009
