





Dear Sir:

The objective of the South Florida Water Management District's Well Abandonment Program is the protection of our drinking water supply. South Florida's ground water resources are endangered by **poorly constructed or abandoned wells**. Plugging these wells prevents saline water from contaminating shallow fresh water aquifers. The District and the United States Geological Survey (USGS) are working together to locate and inventory abandoned artesian wells.

In 1981, the Florida Legislature passed the Water Quality Assurance Act which included a mandate to the water management districts to **plug all abandoned wells by January 1, 1992**. A copy of the relevant section from the Florida Statutes is enclosed for your information.

I am writing this letter to inform you that during our survey in your area, an artesian well(s) was located on your property. We are requesting your **cooperation, assistance and support** for the Well Abandonment Program. By signing a Right of Entry Agreement you will be allowing the District to come onto your property to geophysically log, evaluate and plug (if necessary) this well(s). All costs for this effort are borne by the District and the cooperating agencies. **There will be no cost to you for your cooperation in the program.**

Enclosed is a **Right of Entry Agreement** for your signature and a self addressed envelope for your convenience. Please forward the signed agreement at your earliest convenience.

Thank you for your cooperation and commitment to protecting our drinking water supply. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions or if I can be of any further assistance.

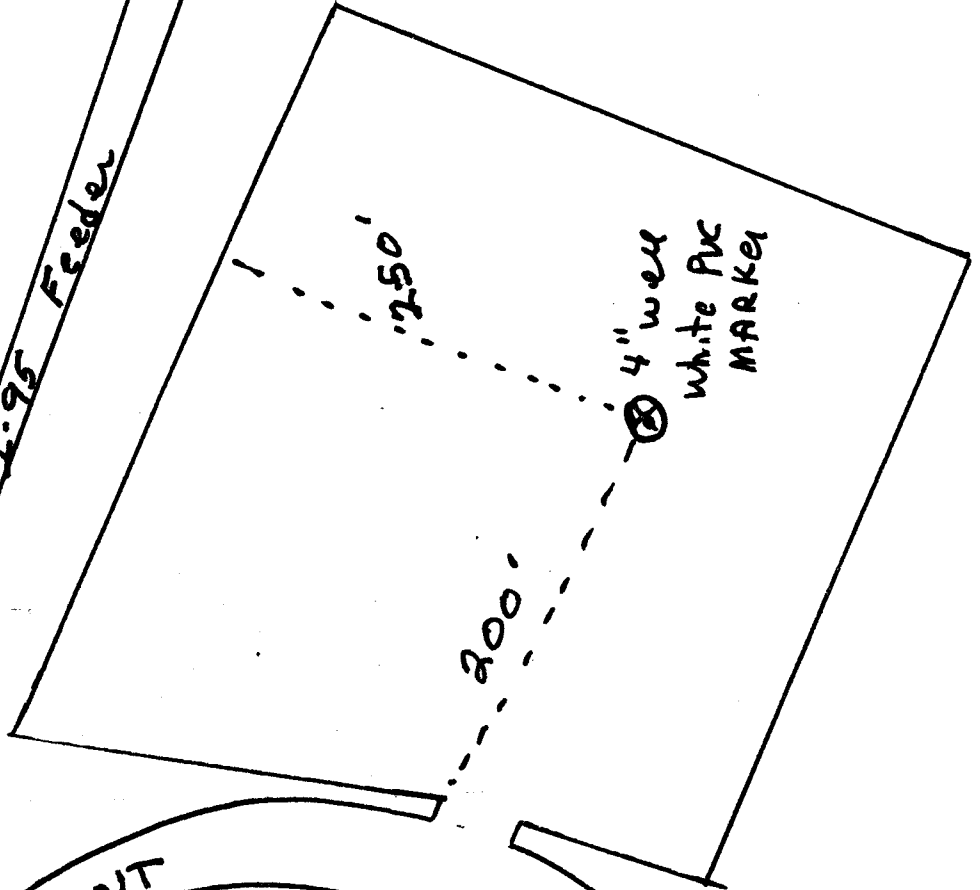
